# **REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DESIGN OF ARTICLES**

1 article of one author and (or) 1 article in co–authorship is accepted from the author for consideration, the number of authors is no more than 3. The material proposed for publication must have scientific novelty and be original (unpublished in other printed publications). The percentage of legitimate borrowings (quoting text with a link) from other sources when analyzed in the free version of the Anti-Plagiarism system is no more than 30% (<a href="https://www.antiplagiat.ru/">https://www.antiplagiat.ru/</a>). The identification of illegal borrowings that violate the principles of academic ethics entails the immediate rejection of the article without the right to submit new material. The responsibility for the unreliability of the stated figures and facts, for the quality of the translation into English of individual parts of the article lies with the author of the publication.

#### TEXT FORMATTING

A4 page format, book page orientation; font – Times New Roman, size – 14 pt, line spacing – 1, alignment of the main text – width; margins: upper, lower, right, left – 2 cm, manual hyphenation is not allowed, paragraph indentation – 1.25 cm; volume of the article: number of characters, including spaces between words, punctuation marks, numbers – at least 6.5 thousand characters (from 3 pages), but not more than 16 thousand characters; abbreviations are deciphered when first used; the text should contain references to the figures and tables used; figures and tables should have ordinal numbering (if there are several of them) a title, a link to the author when borrowing.



## STRUCTURE OF THE ARTICLE

Minsk / Belarus November 14-15 2024

- 1. Surname and initials of the author: no more than 3 people.
- 2. Place of work or study.
- 3. Title: text alignment centered, should reflect the main idea of the study, be as brief as possible.
- 4. Abstract: up to 7 lines, should clearly and concisely state the content of the article.
- 5. Keywords: up to 7 words or phrases separated by semicolons.
- 6. The text of the article: the introduction should be clear, without excessive use of specific concepts and terms, describes the problem field, the relevance of the study, etc.; the main part should contain a description of the research (object, tasks, methodology, etc.), a comparison of the results obtained with the relevant known data, etc.; the conclusion should contain formulated in the thesis The main results obtained are presented, indicating their advantages and application possibilities.
- 7. The list of cited sources (no more than 10) should be located at the end of the text, references are numbered according to the order of citation in the text inside square brackets [1], drawn up according to the recommendations of the Higher Attestation Commission of Belarus <a href="https://www.vak.gov.by/bibliographicDescription">https://www.vak.gov.by/bibliographicDescription</a>.


