From **October 13 to 16, 2026**, the **Second International China-Belarus Forum on the Development of Physical Culture and Sports** will take place in Minsk, Belarus. The 2026 forum is dedicated to the 10th Anniversary of the Confucius Institute at the Belarusian State University of Physical Culture (BSUPC). The event aims to foster international university cooperation and to support the implementation of the Concept and Action Plan for Promoting the Joint Construction of the Silk Road Economic Belt and the 21st Century Maritime Silk Road (the Belt and Road Initiative). The Forum is an annual **international dialogue platform**, held alternately in the cities of Zhanjiang and Minsk. It aims to synchronize scientific interests, share best practices, and strengthen relations between **leading institutions in China, Belarus, and partner countries** in the fields of physical culture, sports, and health-preserving technologies.

The business program's architecture will combine **three types of events**: scientific discussion platforms, practical workshops, and cultural-educational activities.

Participation in the Forum is free of charge. Travel, accommodation, and meal expenses are to be covered by the participants or their sending organizations.

Following the Forum, the Belarusian side plans to publish a digital collection of proceedings.

2. Submit Your Materials (e-mail: nir.bsupc@gmail.com):

- Materials intended for publication.
- A plagiarism check report from an approved system, confirming a minimum originality level of 60%.

* File naming convention: Author's last name(s) and focus area number (e.g., Petrov_1.docx). The text must have a minimum of 60% originality.

PUBLICATION OF PROCEEDINGS

Authors are invited to submit materials in English for consideration: one single-authored paper and/or one co-authored paper. The maximum number of authors per submission is three. The submitted materials must possess scientific novelty and be original (i.e., not previously published in any other printed or electronic source).

Manuscripts will be subject to immediate rejection if they contain:

- Unattributed borrowings that violate the principles of academic ethics;
- Inaccurate data or facts;
- Insufficient quality of English writing;
- Non-compliance with the formatting guidelines.



TEXT FORMATTING

Page Setup: A4 size, portrait orientation.

Font: Times New Roman, 1.5 line spacing.

Alignment: Justified.

Margins: 2.54 cm (1 inch) on all sides (top, bottom, right, left).

Indentation: Paragraph indent – 1.25 cm.

Hyphenation: Manual word hyphenation is not permitted.

Length: from 2 pages, not exceeding 1000 words.

Abbreviations: Must be spelled out at first use.

Figures & Tables: The text should not contain any images or tables.

MANUSCRIPT STRUCTURE

1. **Title:** alignment: centered; must reflect the core idea of the research and be concise; font size: 16 pt.
2. **Author Information:** (maximum of 3 authors): font size: 14 pt.
3. **Author Affiliation Block:** (for each author, include the following)
 - Salutation (Mr. for male, Ms. for female).
 - Academic degree (e.g., PhD in [Field], if applicable).
 - Position (e.g., Professor; Associate Professor; Assistant Professor, etc.).
 - Affiliation (Place of work or study).
 - Contact phone number in international format.
 - E-mail address.
 - Font size: 12 pt.
4. **Abstract:** length: Up to 5 lines; font size: 12 pt.
5. **Research Text:** (Should not contain figures or tables)
 - Must be clear and avoid excessive use of niche concepts and terminology.
 - Should describe the problem area, relevance, and essence of the research.
 - The conclusion should be formulated in a thesis-like manner, stating the main results along with their advantages and potential applications.
 - Font size: 12 pt.
6. **Literature** (Maximum of 7 sources).
 - Placed at the end of the text.
 - Number citations in square brackets: [1], [2], etc.
 - Must be formatted according to the guidelines of the Higher Attestation Commission of Belarus: <https://vak.gov.by/node/8026>
 - Font size: 12 pt.
